



Danish Cleantech Sector – Status:

- Most Danish companies are characterised by:
 - Very smart solutions, high quality, but :
 - Small size (SMV's)
 - Few companies doing export : 10% of all & 1% doing 80%
 - Lack of man-power and ressources to meet export challenges
 - Lack of capital

The objective of Trade Council is to help to increase the export and to help to increase the number of companies doing export



Danish Cleantech Sector and the World:

- Huge global challenges within energy, water & environment:
- The global growth (Asia and Africa) is calling for new sustainable solutions within energy: Wind, Solar, Biomass (in combination with "black" or "grey" solutions – and energy efficiency!)
- Increasing pressure on water resources is calling for solutions within water ressources management, effective water supply, NRW, sewage systems, flooding control etc. etc.
- Growing middle-class in Asia will in general increase demand on clean, healthy environment
- Huge global demand in water – 1000 billion in investments annually – more than half in China alone...



Danish Cleantech Sector – Where to Export?

- To the roaring tigers of Asia?
or
- To the grunting lions of Africa?
or
- Maybe just to Sweden or Germany?



Danish Cleantech Sector – Where to go?

- Africa: Please note that the combined BNP of East African Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Mozambique and Rwanda still is **less than 1/3 of the BNP of Denmark** (South Africa BNP = Denmark BNP)
- Asia: Combined BNP of South East Asian countries Indonesia, Thailand, Malaysia, Singapore and Vietnam is **5 times BNP of Denmark**
- Our European neighbours: More familiar conditions – but almost no growth
- USA?
